UNIFORM POLICY FOR YEARS 7 – 11

All items listed below are available from the College Uniform Suppliers, as detailed on the Uniform List.

The Headmaster will make the final decision on all issues relating to school uniform.

College Blazer

House Tie. When wearing a tie: the top button of the shirt must be fastened; the tie knot placed at the collar of the shirt, the tie knot must of sensible size, the tie must be worn at a sensible length (i.e. to reach just above the waistband of the trousers or skirt). Recipients of 'Colours' ties may wear these in place of House ties.

Plain, white, collared shirt. Shirts must be tucked into trousers/skirts at all times.

Plain, black polished leather (or 'leather look') shoes.

The following footwear is not acceptable: trainers, shoes with open toe design, stilettos or sling backs.

Heels must not exceed 2 cm in height.

Long-sleeved, 'v' neck, dark blue, College pullover or cardigan.

This is an optional item of wear and when used must always be worn with a blazer.

BOYS

GIRLS

Plain, dark grey, tailored trousers

College grey skirt

Must be below the knee - ideally reaching to mid-calf

Plain, black or grey socks

Plain, white ankle socks or plain, black tights

If there is a need to wear an outdoor coat, this should be of sober design and in a dark colour.

If a T-shirt is to be worn under a shirt, this must be nothing else other than plain and white.

Casual leisure wear is not regarded as suitable for school.

Sweatshirts of any description do not qualify as a coat or a sweater and so are not permitted to be worn.

School uniform must be kept clean, tidy and in good repair at all times.

Pupils should arrive at and depart from school dressed according to the terms of this policy.

JEWELLERY

BOYS

GIRLS

No jewellery is to be worn, other than a watch

Those with pierced ears may wear two, plain gold/silver studs or small sleepers - one in each earlobe.
No other jewellery is permitted, other than a watch.

HAIR

Pupils' hair must be clean, tidy, off the face and of reasonable length and style.

Extreme bleaches, highlights or dyes that are in blatant contrast to the hair's natural colour are not permitted. It is also not acceptable to have styles where lines and/or shapes are cut into the hair.

BOYS

GIRLS

'Number 2' or shorter haircuts are not permitted. Hair must not be on or below the collar; the fringe must be above the eye line so as not to obscure vision. Boys must be clean shaven, unless prior written permission has been given by the Headmaster.

Hair must not fall across the face. Hair that is less than shoulder length must be secured by ties that are substantial enough. Hair of shoulder length or longer must be tied back in a ponytail or plaited. Hair bands, ribbons and slides should be in sober, dark colours.
Hair extensions are not permitted.

MAKE-UP

BOYS

GIRLS

No make-up is to be worn. The only exception to this rule is if permission has been granted on medical grounds.

Yrs 7 to 9: no make-up is permitted.
Yrs 10 and 11: discreet make-up is permitted.
Nail varnish or false nails are not permitted.

SCHOOL BAGS

All pupils in Years 7, 8 & 9 must purchase the regulation school bag (rucksack or laptop style).

Pupils in Years 10 & 11 may use their own choice of bag, provided that it is of a sober, dark colour with a minimum of decoration.

PE holdalls can be of individual choice, but should be in sober, dark colours with a minimum of decoration.
