**OUT OF SCHOOL CARE** from 8.00 a.m. – 6.00 p.m. during term time is included in the fees for the Pre-School, Reception, Year 1 and Year 2, as is prep and after school care until 6.00 p.m. for pupils within Years 3 to 6.

### OCCASIONAL BOARDING

No charge is made to parents for the first overnight stay in any academic year. Subsequent stays will be charged at £25 per night (including all meals) up to a maximum of five nights overall. Thereafter nights will be charged at £40 each up to a maximum of 15 further nights (i.e. 20 nights in total) at which point a pupil is expected to become either a weekly or full boarder. Occasional boarding is subject to room availability.

## WHAT THE FEES INCLUDE

- Lunch
- Medical cover and access to the College Counsellor
- Text books and stationery
- Games provision and travel
- Public examination fees for those sitting GCSE examinations
- The use of a College Chromebook within and outside of the school

In addition to the above, the boarding fee is fully inclusive of the following:

- Accommodation
- Food
- Full laundry service
- Wi-Fi provision
- A full programme of weekend activities throughout the academic year for full boarders
- Minibus or train transfers to and from Manchester for full boarders **on the days and times set by the College.**

## WHAT THE FEES DO NOT INCLUDE

- Public examination fees for the IB and other, non GCSE, examinations.
- Special Educational Needs learning support provision, charged at £27 per session (55 minutes) for one-to-one support.
- Additional charges which may be made for some additional items of equipment/services/extra curricular provision as required and notified in advance.

## FINANCIAL MATTERS

A non-refundable **Registration Fee** of **£75** per pupil is payable when an application is made for a place at Scarborough College. Additionally, when a place is offered to a pupil, there is an **Acceptance Contract** to be completed by parents and returned with an **Acceptance Deposit** of **£300**, which will be credited against the final term's fees. The Acceptance Deposit will **not** be refunded if the place is not taken up.

Boarding pupils will also be required to pay a **Boarding Deposit** as outlined below:

UK Boarders	£500
EU Boarders	£1,500
Overseas Boarders	Equal to one term's fees

The Boarding Deposit will be refunded, less any outstanding balance, by 31 August of the year of leaving (or within two calendar months of leaving if this is not at the close of a usual academic year).

One invoice will be issued in early July covering the full fees for the year and all parents are encouraged to take advantage of a Direct Debit system allowing the fees to be paid by ten equal instalments commencing in the September. Statements of account will be issued on request during December and April, showing any fee balance outstanding. Invoices will be issued for any additional charges that may have occurred during a term.

In the event of non-payment of fees, interest will be charged at 8% above the Lloyds Bank Base Rate. The pupil may be excluded from the College until such payment has been made in full.

**Sibling discounts** will be applied for students at a rate of 10% per sibling, i.e. 10% discount for the second child and any subsequent children that attend the school.

**One full term's notice** in writing to the Headmaster is required for the withdrawal of a pupil from the College. If such notice is not given by 2 September 2019 for the Easter Term 2020, by 7 January 2020 for the Summer Term 2020, or by 27 April 2020 for the Christmas Term 2020, one full term's fees at the published rate will be payable in lieu of notice. **One full term's notice is required if a Year 11 pupil is not continuing into the Sixth Form.**

The College fees are reviewed annually and fixed by the governing body. Any increase will be notified in writing with at least one term's notice. No reduction in fees is made for non-attendance at the College due to sickness, holidays or any other cause.

Other regulations are set out within the College's **Standard Terms and Conditions** which are sent to parents/guardians at the point of an offer of a place.
