### SCHOLARSHIPS AND FINANCIALLY ASSISTED PLACES

In keeping with its charitable status, Scarborough College is committed to the pursuit of educational excellence and to widening access to the College for students who would not normally be able to afford a place. The following Scholarships are available:

#### WHOLE SCHOOL

**The Scarborough Scholar** Annually, the College may award up to a 100% reduction in fees in connection with a new pupil entry into either the Junior School or Senior School. The Scarborough Scholar Assessment Day takes place every November and applications can be submitted via the Admissions Team. This award is means-tested.

#### YEARS 7 TO 11

**Academic Scholarship** Worth up to a maximum of a 20% reduction in fees for the duration of the child's time at the school up to Year 11.

**Music Scholarship** Worth up to a maximum of a 15% reduction in fees, plus free music tuition for one instrument for the duration of the child's time at the school up to Year 11.

**Sport Scholarship** Worth up to a maximum of a 20% reduction in fees for the duration of the child's time at the school up to Year 11.

**All-rounder** Worth up to a maximum of a 20% reduction in fees for the duration of the child's time at the school up to Year 11.

#### EU AND OVERSEAS STUDENTS

**Maths Scholarship** Worth a reduction of £500 per term.

**Hartford Scholarship** Available to students aged 11-16 applying from the EU and Overseas, representing a reduction of £100 per annum.

**Alderson Scholarship** Specifically designed for international students already in Year 11 at Scarborough College, who wish to remain and study the IB in our Sixth Form. This is an academic scholarship worth up to a maximum of £2,000 per annum.

#### FINANCIALLY ASSISTED PLACES

Financially assisted places are means tested and the criteria are as follows:

- An acceptable standard in the entrance assessments.
- Satisfactory school reports.
- Evidence of enthusiasm and commitment in the extra curricular arena, e.g. sport, music, drama, etc.

The financial assistance can be very substantial and applicant families are means tested in order to ensure that places are awarded fairly. The level of assistance is reviewed annually. Pupils in receipt of a financially assisted place must also maintain the highest standards of conduct, endeavour and commitment throughout their time at the College.
