APPENDIX 6 – SPORTS KIT

Pupils should only be wearing games / sports clothing when they are involved in an official activity or have specific permission from a member of staff that has been sanctioned for them to be out of normal school uniform (see details below).

If given permission to arrive in kit on a school day, Scarborough College tracksuit bottoms should be worn to and around school at all times. Mid-layers / tracksuit tops (if worn) must also have a base / lower layer worn.

(Pupils playing recreational sports at break or lunch time may change their shoes and wear trainers but must change back into their normal shoes once off the play areas and before entering buildings).

All compulsory sports kit items for pupils from Reception to Year 11 (with the exception of some footwear) are available from the designated College uniform supplier, School Blazer www.schoolblazer.com

Only official College sports kit can be worn for PE lessons (academic or curriculum), sports sessions, coaching sessions, 1-2-1 sessions, fixtures or Yorkshire Grit. Alternative kit is not acceptable, and pupils will be required to change into Scarborough College kit to continue with the session.

- *All students playing Hockey must have shin pads and gum shields, gum shields are also compulsory for Rugby. SC gum shields can be purchased from OPRO, any other suitable gum shields are also acceptable.*

Games afternoons

Students are allowed to be in Sports Kit when they have games afternoons:

Tuesday	Years 9 and Year 10
Wednesday	Year 11, Year 12 and Year 13
Thursday	Year 7 and Year 8

Fixtures

For Rugby and Hockey fixtures students should wear shorts/ skorts and the reversible match tops

	Change at
Session before school, P1 or P2 and no other sport sessions, GRIT or sport EP	Break (back into uniform)
Session after break	Break (arrive to school in uniform change into sports kit)
Session P5, P6, EP	Lunch (arrive to school in uniform change into sports kit)
Fixtures: as above for leaving times, unless an all-day fixture where students can wear sports kit to travel.

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Hockey Match Kit

Shirt	Scarborough College match shirt (reversible)
Shorts/Skort	Official navy playing shorts/skort.
Socks	College hockey socks.
Base Layers	Navy or black base layers only (if worn).
Footwear	Appropriate hockey shoes suitable for the surface (astro/indoor).
Equipment	Stick, gum shield, and shin pads are compulsory.



Additional Guidance

Goalkeepers must wear full protective equipment as issued or approved by the College.
Players should travel to and from fixtures in College midlayer and tracksuits. unless advised otherwise by coaching staff.

Cricket Match Kit

Shirt	Official Scarborough College cricket shirt (short or long sleeve).
Trousers	Official white cricket trousers.
Sweater	College cricket sweater (optional, weather dependent).
Footwear	White cricket shoes or clean sports trainers.
Cap	College cricket cap (optional but encouraged).

Additional Guidance

Pupils should wear whites for all fixtures unless otherwise directed (e.g., coloured kit for limited-overs/tour fixtures). **No club kit allowed**

Pupils must bring their school blazer for fixtures to wear for tea.

All players are encouraged to have their own personal protective equipment (pads, gloves, box, helmet, etc.) appropriate to age and regulations. The College can provide kit if necessary.





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Netball Match Kit

- Shirt Scarborough College match shirt (or fitness t-shirt, as directed by staff).
- Shorts/Skort Official navy playing shorts/skort.
- Socks White sports socks.
- Base Layers Navy or black base layers only (if worn).
- Footwear Appropriate shoes suitable for the surface (courts or indoor).
- Bib Team positional bibs (provided by the College).

Rugby Match Kit

- Shirt Scarborough College match shirt.
- Shorts Official navy rugby shorts.
- Socks College rugby socks.
- Base Layers Navy or black base layers only (if worn).
- Footwear Studded rugby boots (must comply with RFU safety standards)
- Mouthguard Compulsory for all training and matches.

Additional Guidance

Gum shields should be properly fitted and checked regularly.
 Studs will be checked by coaches before play for safety compliance.
 Players must travel to and from fixtures in College midlayer and tracksuit bottoms unless otherwise directed.

Travel and Presentation

When travelling to fixtures (home or away), all pupils must wear College midlayer and tracksuits..
 Pupils should maintain a smart and respectful appearance at all times when representing the College.
 Post-match wear (e.g., tracksuit) should also be clean and presentable.

Responsibilities

Pupils are responsible for ensuring they have the correct kit for all fixtures.
 Parents/Guardians are expected to support pupils in maintaining kit cleanliness and readiness.
 Staff and Coaches will ensure consistent enforcement of the policy and communicate any specific fixture requirements in advance.
