UNIFORM POLICY

Scarborough College pupils are expected to look smart at all times during the school day. As a standard, the following is expected:

Uniform and Appearance

- 1 Full school uniform should be worn at all times; this includes games kit as stipulated at the appropriate times. Hoodies do not form part of the school uniform.
- 2 Hair should be clean, neat and tidy, without artificial colouring or extremes of style, hair extensions are not permitted. Boys should be clean shaven, unless prior written permission has been given by the Headmaster. Hair should not come below the collar or fall across the eyes. Girls hair should be tied back whenever school uniform is worn. Sixth Form girls may wear their hair down if this is deemed acceptable by the Senior Deputy Head.
- 3 All pupils shoe wear must be flat, polished and black. Sixth Form girls are not permitted to wear open toe design or trainers, no boots, no stilettos or sling backs, heels no greater than 2 cm.
- 4 No jewellery may be worn, with the exception of, one pair of gold/silver sleepers, stud or small loop earrings. No jewellery to be worn during games sessions/matches. Discreet make-up is allowed for Sixth Form girls only. The only exception to this rule is if permission has been granted on medical grounds.
- 5 Official school games kit should not be worn at any time other than for sports-based activities or when permission has been given by a member of staff – see appendices.
- 6 Clothing and shoe wear should be clean and in good repair.
- 7 Shirts/blouses must be tucked into trousers/skirts at all times. When wearing a tie the top button of the shirt must be fastened, the tie knot placed at the collar of the shirt, the tie knot must be a sensible size, the tie must be worn at a sensible length, i.e. to reach just above the waistband of the trousers.
- 8 Skirts should be of a suitable length for a school setting. As a guide, skirts should be no shorter than just above the knee when standing. Students may be asked to adjust or replace skirts that do not meet this expectation.
- 9 When in school uniform, Jackets are to be worn at all times. In the event of warm weather, alternative uniform arrangements will be published by the Senior Deputy Head.
- 10 If there is a need to wear an outdoor coat, Pre-School pupils can wear the crested coat, as supplied by Identity. For pupils in Reception to Year 6 they may wear the College crested coat as supplied by School Blazer. All pupils can wear their own outdoor coat, however this should be of sober design and in a dark colour.
- 11 Pupils are expected to arrive and depart in full school uniform according to the terms in this policy. This includes walking to and from the College as well as travelling on the College bus service.
- 12 All pupils must purchase the regulation school bag. College games bag are available. PE holdalls can be of individual choice, but should be in sober, dark colours with a minimum of decoration. Sixth Form bags can be of individual choice, but should be in sober, dark colours with a minimum of decoration.
- 13 All uniform and kit should be **clearly named**.
- 14 With the exception of 'tailoring to fit' Items of uniform must not be manually altered (for example waistbands must not be rolled down).
- 15 Safety items, such as shin-pads and gum-shields, are compulsory for rugby and hockey.
- 16 Adjudication on uniform and appearance are at the discretion of the Headmaster.

For pupils in Reception to Year 11 all uniform items (with the exception of some footwear) are available from the designated College uniform supplier, School Blazer. Sports kit for all pupils in Reception to Sixth Form is also available from School Blazer www.schoolblazer.com.
